L.P. ORDINANCE NO. 18-19

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE MILLAGE RATES AS ADJUSTED FOR THE TAX YEAR 2018

BE IT ORDAINED by the Livingston Parish Council, governing authority of the PARISH OF Livingston, State of Louisiana, in a public meeting held on July 12, 2018, which meeting was conducted in accordance with the Open Meetings Law, and the additional requirements of Article VII, Section 23 (C) of the Louisiana constitution and Louisiana Revised Statutes 47:1705 (B), et seq. and pursuant to Section 2-11 A(3) of the Home Rule Charter of the President-Council, that the following adjusted millage rates be and they are hereby levied upon the dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property subject to ad valorem taxation within said Parish for the year 2018, for the purpose of raising revenue: Said millages are:

TAX	MILLAGE
Parish/Local	1.16
Parish	2.32
Road Equipment & Maintenance	5.00
Library Bond	1.5
Health Unit	2.50

The Assessor of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, shall extend upon the assessment roll of said Parish for the year 2018, and the taxes herein levied, and the tax collector of said Parish shall collect and remit the same to said taxing authority in accordance with the law.
