L.P. ORDINANCE NO. 21-06

AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE THAT LA TRACE ROAD IS A PARISH MAINTAINED ROAD BEING TWENTY THREE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY FEET (23,760') LONG.

L.P. ORDINANCE NO. 21-06

AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE THAT LA TRACE ROAD IS A PARISH MAINTAINED ROAD BEING TWENTY THREE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY FEET (23,760') LONG.

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2002 at a regular meeting of the Livingston Parish Council, Public Works Director Grant Bankston presented a booklet containing a complete listing of Parish maintained and Capital Outlay Roads throughout the Parish to each Council member; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2002, at a regular meeting of the Livingston Parish Council, LPR NO. 02-478 was adopted, accepting the Complete Road List contained in the Livingston Parish Maintained Roads and Capital Outlay Roads booklet submitted to the Council as a complete listing of roads to be accepted into the Parish maintenance system; and

WHEREAS, Public Works Director Grant Bankston affirmed that the Complete Road List was a list of roads to be included in the overlay program and listed every public road that existed in the Parish that is Parish owned, Parish maintained and/or bladed by the Parish being both gravel and blacktopped; and

WHEREAS, said booklet is on file and maintained in the official records of the Livingston Parish Council, also being known as the "Grant Bankston List"; and

WHEREAS, LA Trace Road is listed on page 20 of the "Grant Bankston List" as Segment #1121, Priority Medium, Condition 0, Area 6, Location LA 16, Length 23,760 feet, Type GVL, Class Collector, Year Blt 8; and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council now desires to adopt an ordinance to confirm and verify that LA Trace Road is a Parish maintained road being in length of 23,760 feet.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Livingston Parish Council that:

LA TRACE ROAD is confirmed as a Parish maintained road having been accepted into the Parish of Livingston's maintenance system being in length of 23,760 feet; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that pursuant to all applicable provisions of law, the Livingston Parish Department of Public Works is directed and authorized to assess, deem, designate, and determine that LA Trace Road is maintained by the Parish of Livingston being in length of 23,760 feet; and

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective upon the date of adoption.
