**L.P. ORDINANCE 21-12**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 18, "DISASTER EMERGENCIES", ARTICLE II, "COMMUNICATIONS", SECTION 18-27, "SAFETY REGULATIONS," OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IN AND FOR THE PARISH OF LIVINGSTON.

The following ordinance, which was previously introduced in written form required for adoption at a regular meeting of the Parish Council on April 22, 2021, a summary thereof having been published in the official journal together with a notice of public hearing which was held in accordance with said public notice was brought up for final passage May 13, 2021, on Motion of Tracy Girlinghouse and seconded by Shane Mack:

#### **L.P. ORDINANCE 21-12**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 18, "DISASTER EMERGENCIES", ARTICLE II, "COMMUNICATIONS", SECTION 18-27, "SAFETY REGULATIONS," OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IN AND FOR THE PARISH OF LIVINGSTON.

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council adopted L.P.O. 13-11 on April 25, 2013, creating Chapter 14.3, "Safety Regulations", Article I, "In General", Section 14.3-1, entitled "Safety Regulations" of the Code of Ordinances of Livingston Parish, therefore adopting the Livingston Parish Regulations Booklet; and

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2019 the Livingston Parish Code of Ordinances was recodified revising Chapter 14.3, "Safety Regulations", Article I, "In General", Section 14.3-1, "Safety Regulations", to be hereby known as Chapter 18, "Disaster Emergencies", Article II, "Communications", Section 18-27, "Safety Regulations"; and

WHEREAS, the changes proposed in L.P. Ordinance 19-08 to add provisions in respect to digital file distribution to the Livingston Parish Regulations Booklet, Commercial Building/Hazardous Materials Operations; Section 2 "Requirements", are still in effect in the Livingston Parish Regulations Booklet but serve no purpose in the Livingston Parish Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council now wishes to amend Section 14.3-1. "Safety Regulations" to reflect the date of the recently revised Livingston Parish Regulations Booklet and to strike-out the amendments made in L.P.O. 19-08 to our code of ordinances with the understanding that the changes were made and are still effective in the Livingston Parish Regulations Booklet;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana: The Code of Ordinances of Livingston Parish, Section 18-27, "Safety Regulations", is hereby amended identifying the existing paragraph known as paragraph (a), will remain in the Code of Ordinances and strike the alphabetical (a) from the paragraph therefore leaving it existing without alphabetical numeration, and further amending, by striking paragraph (b) as it is listed, but shall remain effective as it serves no purpose listed in the Code of Ordinances to read as follows:

#### **Section 14.3-1. Safety Regulations**

~~(a)~~ The Livingston Parish Regulations Booklet, dated September 12, 2013 Edition or any future revisions of said booklet as approved by the Council by resolution, a copy of which is available in the office of the council clerk, is hereby adopted as the revised safety regulations of the parish for regulating hazardous material, explosives, underground pipelines, new gas or liquid pipeline construction and placement and the providing for the issuance of permits and fees therefor, and each and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of the Livingston Parish Regulations Booklet, are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this section.

~~(b)~~ ~~The following additions/revisions are hereby made to the Livingston Parish Regulations Booklet:~~  
~~*Operations and Activities, Commercial Building/Hazardous Materials Operations, Section 2 "Requirements", part (a) and part (a) (2) shall read as follows:*~~

~~(a) The operating business/owner of each commercial building, including those required to submit Tier II reporting to the State (see Title 33, Part V, Subpart 2, Chapter 101 and Summary of Right to Know Law), located within Livingston Parish is required to submit electronic floor plans/layouts in PDF format, as well as a description of current operations, to the Livingston Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness.~~

~~(2) Any new commercial buildings/operations, including those required to submit Tier II reporting to the State (see Title 33, Part V, Subpart 2, Chapter 101 and Summary of Right to Know Law), must submit the required floor plans/layouts to the Livingston Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness no later than two (2)~~

~~calendar days prior to final inspection/s. Floor plans/layouts shall include the following:~~

- ~~a. All windows and doors with sizes of each~~
- ~~b. FDC connection locations~~
- ~~c. All fire hydrant locations~~
- ~~d. Sprinkler/riser room location~~
- ~~e. Location of connections and providers of gas, water, and electrical~~

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
