NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following entitled ordinance was introduced in writing in the form required for adoption at a meeting of the Parish Council of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, on December 8, 2011, and laid over for publication of notice:

L.P. ORDINANCE NO. 11-35

AN ORDINANCE ALTERING THE BOUNDARIES OF GRAVITY DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 6 OF THE PARISH OF LIVINGSTON, STATE OF LOUISIANA.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the Parish Council of said Parish will meet on Thursday, January 12, 2012, at six (6:00) o'clock p.m., at the Livingston Parish Governmental Building, Council Meeting Chambers, located at 20355 Governmental Boulevard, Livingston, Louisiana, at which time there will be a public hearing on the adoption of the aforesaid ordinance.

The following ordinance which was previously introduced in written form at a regular meeting of the Parish Council on December 8, 2011, a Notice of Public Hearing having been published in the official journal and which public hearing was held in accordance with said public notice, was offered by _____ and seconded by _____:

L.P. ORDINANCE NO. 11-35

AN ORDINANCE ALTERING THE BOUNDARIES OF GRAVITY DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 6 OF THE PARISH OF LIVINGSTON, STATE OF LOUISIANA.

WHEREAS, pursuant to L.P. Ordinance No. 09-11 and La. R.S. 38:1751 et. seq., the Livingston Parish Council, acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority") created Gravity Drainage District No. 6 of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana (the "District"); and

WHEREAS, the Governing Authority now desires to amend Section 14-178 of the Code of Ordinances of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana to amend the boundaries of the District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Parish Council, as the governing authority of the Parish, that:

SECTION 1. Section 14-178 of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 14-178. Boundaries

The gravity drainage district created in this division shall contain within its boundaries all of the property described as follows, to wit:

Commencing at the intersection of the Livingston/St. Helena parish line and the centerline of Middle Colyell Creek; thence, in an easterly direction, along the Livingston/St. Helena parish line to it's intersection with the Livingston/Tangipahoa parish line; thence, in a southerly direction, along the Livingston/Tangipahoa parish line to it's intersection with the centerline of Interstate Highway 12; thence, in a westerly direction, along the centerline of Interstate Highway 12 to it's intersection with the centerline of Middle Colyell Creek; thence, in a northerly direction, along the centerline of Middle Colyell Creek to it's intersection with the south line of the City of Walker; thence, in an easterly direction, to the southeast corner of the City of Walker; thence, in a northerly direction, along the east line of the City of Walker to it's intersection with the centerline of U.S. Highway 190; thence, in a northeasterly direction, along the centerline of U.S. Highway 190 to it's intersection with a line 300 feet east and parallel to State Highway 449; thence, in a northerly direction, along a line 300 feet east and parallel to State Highway 449 to it's intersection with the north line of Section 20, T6S-R4E; thence, in a westerly direction, along the north line of Sections 19 and 20, T6S-R4E to it's intersection with the centerline of Middle Colyell Creek; thence, in a northerly direction, along the centerline of Middle Colyell Creek to the POINT OF BEGINNING:

LESS AND EXCEPT THEREFROM:

A certain tract of land located in sections 20,21,28, and 29, Township 6 South, Range 4 East, Greensburg Land District, Livingston Parish, Louisiana, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the existing northeast corner of the existing corporate limits of the town of Walker, proceed easterly along the north boundary line of the J.H. Jenkins property and section 29, T6S-R4E, to the northwest corner of the Industrial Park Property; thence easterly along the northern boundary of the Industrial Park property to the northeast corner of the Industrial Park Property; thence southerly along the east boundary of the Industrial Park Property to the southern R/W of U.S. Hwy. 190; thence westerly along the southern R/W of U.S. Hwy. 190 to the existing corporate limits of the town of Walker; thence northerly along the existing corporate limits of the town of Walker back to the point of beginning containing approximately 284 acres more or less.”

SECTION 2. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items, or applications of this Ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid provision, or application, and to this end the provision of this Ordinance are hereby declared severable.

SECTION 3. The Chairman and Clerk of the Governing Authority, along with the Parish President are further authorized and directed to do any and all things necessary and incidental to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
