NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following entitled ordinance was introduced in writing in the form required for adoption at a meeting of the Parish Council of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, on March 8, 2012, and laid over for publication of notice:

L.P. ORDINANCE NO. 12-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PARISH ORDINANCE 06-38 AND PARISH ORDINANCE 06-41 AND ESTABLISHING THE METHOD OF PAYMENT AND PROVIDING FOR THE FULL-TIME STATUS OF COUNCIL CLERK, DEPUTY CLERK AND OFFICE ASSISTANT 1 AND MAKING SALARY PROVISIONS AS SET FORTH MORE FULLY HEREIN.

L.P. ORDINANCE NO. 12-06

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 12-02 AND AMENDING PARISH ORDINANCE 06-38 AND PARISH ORDINANCE 06-41 AND ESTABLISHING THE METHOD OF PAYMENT AND PROVIDING FOR THE FULL-TIME STATUS OF COUNCIL CLERK, DEPUTY CLERK AND OFFICE ASSISTANT 1 AND MAKING SALARY PROVISIONS AS SET FORTH MORE FULLY HEREIN.

WHEREAS, Section 2-10 (A) of the Home Rule Charter of Livingston Parish shall, by vote of its authorized membership, appoint a clerk of the Council who shall serve at the pleasure of the Council. The clerk shall give notice of Council meetings to its members and the public, keep the journal of its proceedings, be official secretary of the Council and perform such other duties as are assigned to the position by the Charter or by the Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-10 (B) of the Home Rule Charter of Livingston Parish establishes the Council may, by ordinance approved by two-thirds of its authorized membership, authorize the hiring of such other employees as may be necessary to assist the Council in carrying out its duties and responsibilities. Such employees shall serve at the pleasure of the Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-10 (C) of the Home Rule Charter of Livingston Parish mandates the Council shall, by ordinance approved by two-thirds of its authorized membership, fix the salaries of its employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Livingston Parish Council that the salary and compensation for Council clerk shall be \$50,000 annually, the Deputy clerk shall be \$40,000 annually and the Office Assistant 1 shall be \$15.30 an hour.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Council clerk's salary, the Deputy clerk's salary and the Office Assistant 1 salary be retroactive from the date of January 17, 2012.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Livingston Parish Council, governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, that if any provision of this ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items, or applications of this ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Livingston Parish Council that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

The effective date of this ordinance shall be as prescribed by law.
