AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE IV OF CHAPTER 13 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF LIVINGSTON PARISH, "ROADS AND DRAINAGE," SECTION 13-54 AS FOLLOWS:

L.P. ORDINANCE 13-07

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE IV OF CHAPTER 13 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF LIVINGSTON PARISH, "ROADS AND DRAINAGE," SECTION 13-54 AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, as the Livingston Parish Police Jury, governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana established requirements for streets or roads in October 27, 1973; and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council by LPO 09-28 pursuant to a submitted initiative petition did enact amendment provisions for street and road standards; and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council desires to protect the citizens from rain-event road flooding; and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council now desires to make further amendments to standardize the Code of Ordinances and amend further these standards.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Livingston Parish Council, governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana:

Sec. 13-54 – Streets

(i) Elevation of All roads must be equal to or above the 10-year storm based on drainage calculations and projected hydraulic grade lines.

Sec. 13.54.1 – Street standards

- (b) Design and Construction Criteria
 - (1)(c) With eight (8) inches of four thousand (4,000) psi concrete on eight-inch compacted base; or
 - (3)(c) With eight(8) inches of four thousand (4,000) psi concrete on eight-inch compacted base; or
 - (3)(d) With six (6) inches of four thousand (4,000) psi concrete and three (3) inches of hot asphaltic concrete wearing surface on eight-inch compated base.

Sec. 13-54.3 – Final acceptance of streets and improvements

The O/D/S must maintain all streets and improvements for a period of eighteen (18) months from acceptance for maintenance period. Before the end of the eighteen-month period, a final inspection must be made by the department of public works and the review engineer who recommend to the parish council whether or not to accept the streets and improvements into the parish maintenance system.

All repairs including crack sealing must be completed.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

The effective date of this ordinance shall be as prescribed b	y law.
