

NOTICE OF INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following entitled ordinance was introduced in writing in the form required for adoption at a meeting of the Parish Council of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, on March 14, 2013, and laid over for publication of notice:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 14 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF LIVINGSTON PARISH, "ROADS AND DRAINAGE," SECTION 14-3, "TYPE A ROADS," SECTION 14-4, "TYPE B ROADS," SECTION 14-5, "TYPE C ROADS," AND SECTION 14-6, "ALTERNATIVE BASE," AS FOLLOWS:

The following ordinance, which was previously introduced in written form required for adoption at a regular meeting of the Parish Council on March 14, 2013 a summary thereof having been published in the official journal together with a notice of public hearing which was held in accordance with said public notice, was brought up for final passage April 11, 2013, on Motion of _____ and seconded by _____:

L.P. ORDINANCE 13-08

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 14 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF LIVINGSTON PARISH, "ROADS AND DRAINAGE," SECTION 14-3, "TYPE A ROADS," SECTION 14-4, "TYPE B ROADS," SECTION 14-5, "TYPE C ROADS," AND SECTION 14-6, "ALTERNATIVE BASE," AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, as the Livingston Parish Police Jury, governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana established requirements for streets or roads in October 27, 1973; and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council by LPO 09-28 pursuant to a submitted initiative petition did enact amendment provisions for street and road standards; and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council now desires to make further amendments to standardize the Code of Ordinances and amend further these standards.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Livingston Parish Council, governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana:

Sec. 14-3. - Type A roads.

Type A streets or roads must meet the following requirements prior to acceptance by the police jury:

- (1) Right-of-way, not less than fifty (50) feet in width for curb and gutter and sixty (60) feet for open ditch.
- (2) Crown of road, not less than twenty-six (26) feet in width except curb and gutter.
- (3) Surface of road, not less than twenty (20) feet in width with not less than eight (8) inches of concrete.
- (4) Base, not less than compacted natural ground for a width of not less than twenty-one (21) feet except for curb and gutter.

Sec. 14-5. - Type C roads.

Except for the alternative base in section 14-6, type C streets or roads must meet the following requirements prior to acceptance by the police jury:

- (1) Right-of-way, not less than fifty (50) feet in width for curb and gutter and 60' for open ditch.
- (2) Crown of road, not less than twenty-six (26) feet in width except for curb and gutter.
- (3) Surface of road, not less than twenty (20) feet in width with not less three (3) inch application of asphaltic concrete (1.5 inch and 1.5 inch layers).
- (4) Base, not less than ten (10) inches of soil cement to be not less than twenty-one (21) feet in width except curb and gutter.

Sec. 14-5. - Type C roads.

Except for the alternative base in section 14-6, type C streets or roads must meet the following requirements prior to acceptance by the parish council. (Refer to Chapter 13, section 13-5.1, paragraph C).

All of "Section 14-6 – Alternative base," is hereby deleted in its entirety.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

The effective date of this ordinance shall be as prescribed by law.
