L.P. ORDINANCE 13-11

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE BY ADDING CHAPTER 14.3 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF LIVINGSTON PARISH, ENTITLED “SAFETY REGULATIONS” AND ADOPTING THE LIVINGSTON PARISH REGULATIONS BOOKLET.

WHEREAS, as the Livingston Parish Council, is the governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, life-safety concerns for the citizens of Livingston Parish have arisen as a result of the recent activity of oil, gas and mineral drilling, and the Livingston Parish Council desires to establish regulations that govern potentially hazardous activity; and

WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana grants authority to the Parish President to establish and maintain a homeland security and emergency preparedness agency under LA R.S. 29 for the protection of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council now desires to establish in its Code of Ordinances, a Chapter dedicated to Safety Regulations;

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Livingston Parish Council, governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana:

Chapter 14.3 – Safety Regulations

Article 1 – General

Section 14.3.1 – Safety Regulations

The Livingston Parish Regulations Booklet, dated April 25, 2013 Edition, a copy of which is available in the office of the council clerk, is hereby adopted as the safety regulations of the parish for regulating hazardous material, explosives, underground pipelines, new gas or liquid pipeline construction and placement and the providing for the issuance of permits and fees therefor, and each each and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of the Livingston Parish Regulations Booklet, April 25, 2013 edition, are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this section.

The ordinance shall become effective upon date of adoption.
