AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17, ARTICLE VI, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF LIVINGSTON PARISH, "WATER, SEWER AND GAS," BY AMENDING SECTION 17-280, "DEFINITIONS", TO PROVIDE FOR A TAP-IN FEE, CONNECTION FEE, TAMPERING FEE, AMEND SECTION 17-291, "UTILITY RATES AND CHARGES ESTABLISHED", AND ALSO TO REVISE WATER UTILITY RATES BY AMENDING SECTION 17-297, "UTILITIES FEE SCHEDULE, EXHIBIT A - WATER", AND TO AMEND SECTION 17-298, PART B, "DISCONTINUATON OF SERVICE BY PARISH".

The following ordinance which was previously introduced in written form required for adoption at a regular meeting of the Livingston Parish Council on Thursday, April 25, 2013, a summary thereof having been published in the Official Journal together with a notice of public hearing which was held in accordance with said public notice, was brought up for final passage on Thursday, May 23, 2013, on Motion of ______ and seconded by ______:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17, ARTICLE VI, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF LIVINGSTON PARISH, "WATER, SEWER AND GAS," BY AMENDING SECTION 17-280, "DEFINITIONS", TO PROVIDE FOR A TAP-IN FEE, CONNECTION FEE, TAMPERING FEE, AMEND SECTION 17-291, "UTILITY RATES AND CHARGES ESTABLISHED", AND ALSO TO REVISE WATER UTILITY RATES BY AMENDING SECTION 17-297, "UTILITIES FEE SCHEDULE, EXHIBIT A - WATER", AND TO AMEND SECTION 17-298, PART B, "DISCONTINUATON OF SERVICE BY PARISH".

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council adopted LP Ordinance 05-33 on September 22, 2005, supplementing the Code of Ordinances of the Parish of Livingston by adding Article VI, "Utility Operations;" and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council subsequently amended Section VI of Chapter 17 of the Code of Ordinances by adopting LP Ordinances 07-31 and 09-19 and 09-24; and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council now finds it prudent and necessary to make further amendments to Chapter 17, Article VI, "Utility Operations," in order for the Parish of Livingston's Utilities to transition with the French Settlement Water Company/Livingston Parish Utilities Cooperative Endeavor Agreement and establish procedures and rates to be as similar as possible;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Parish Council of Livingston Parish, Louisiana: **Section 17-280. Definitions**. Of the Code of Ordinances of the Parish of Livingston, Louisiana, is hereby amended as follows by adding:

Connection fee means the actual cost incurred by the Parish in making the physical connection to the water system, including both direct and indirect costs.

Tapping fee means the actual cost incurred by the Parish of Livingston in making the physical connection between the customer's service line and the water system, including both direct and indirect costs.

Tampering fee means a charge assessed when a customer by-passes a meter, turns their service on without notifying the water system or otherwise tampers with the water system's meter, meter box or other integral part of the meter service assembly. Said tampering fee charged to the customer will be the cost to replace or repair any and all damage and will not be less than \$65.00.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Parish Council of Livingston Parish, Louisiana: **Section 17-291. Utility rates and charges established**. Of the Code of Ordinances of the Parish of Livingston, Louisiana, is hereby amended by deleting paragraph (c) and adding the following:

Paragraph (c) Connection fees, Hookup fees, and Tapping fees. The connection fee, hookup fee and tapping fee as per Exhibit A of this section will be collected at the time of application is made for water and/or sewer service.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Parish Council of Livingston Parish, Louisiana: **Section 17-297. Utilities fee schedule**. Of the Code of Ordinances of the Parish of Livingston, Louisiana, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 17-297 of the Code of Ordinances is rescinded in accordance with LP Ordinance 09-24 adopted October 8, 2009, and is hereby reinstated as it pertains to the amended Schedule A, **attached hereto**, and shall read as follows:

Sec. 17-297. All fees related to water and sewer services in the Parish of Livingston shall be in accordance with Exhibit A, as follows:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Parish Council of Livingston Parish, Louisiana:

Section 17-298. Discontinuance and restoration of service. PART (B), Discontinuance of service by parish. Of the Code of Ordinances of the Parish of Livingston, is hereby amended by deleting paragraph (b) its entirety and adding the following:

(b) Service under any application and any other public or private use, may be discontinued for

any of the following reasons:

- (1) For misrepresentation in application as to property to be served or fixtures to be supplied, or the use to be made of the water supply.
- (2) For the use of water for any other property or purpose than that described in the application.
- (3) For non-payment of any water bill for more than thirty (30) days after the same is due.
- (4) For molesting any service pipe, meter, curb stop, corporation stop, seal, or any other appliance of the Company controlling or regulating the water supply.
- (5) In case of vacancy of premises.
- (6) For violation of any of the rules contained herein.
- (7) Refusal to permit inspection of plumbing by representatives of the Water Company at reasonable hours.
- (8) Where service has been discontinued for violation of any rule contained herein, the Company shall not be required to restore service until all unpaid accounts due from the customer to the Company have been paid in full, plus a reconnection charge, and a deposit is posted or increased, if necessary.
- (9) When service is discontinued for any other cause, it will not be restored until the cause of the suspension has been removed or remedied.
- (10) The Company shall not be liable for damage occasioned by suspension of service when such suspension is affected in accordance with these provisions.

All bills unpaid twenty (20) days after billing date will be delinquent. After a total of thirty (30) days following billing date, if bill is still unpaid, the Company shall have the right after due written notice of such non-payment to the last known address, to discontinue service seven (7) days following sending of notice and shall not be required to restore service until all unpaid accounts due from the customer to the Company have been paid in full, plus a reconnection charge, and a deposit is posted or increased, if necessary.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Livingston Parish Council that if any provision of this ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items, or applications of this ordinance, which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.
