NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following entitled ordinance was introduced in writing in the form required for adoption at a meeting of the Parish Council of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, on April 25, 2013 and laid over for publication of notice:

LIVINGSTON PARISH ORDINANCE NO. 13-19

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REENACT SECTION 10-9(a), “STOP SIGNS, THREE-WAY STOP,” OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IN AND FOR THE PARISH OF LIVINGSTON, TO ADD THE INTERSECTION AT GLENBROOKE DRIVE AND MILLSTONE, AND GLENBROOKE DRIVE AND POPLAR GLEN.

The following ordinance, which was previously introduced in written form at a regular meeting of the Parish Council on April 25, 2013, a summary thereof having been published in the official journal together with a notice of public hearing which was held in accordance with said public notice, was brought up for final passage May 23, 2013, on motion of _____ and seconded by _____:

LIVINGSTON PARISH ORDINANCE NO. 13-____

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REENACT SECTION 10-9(a), "STOP SIGNS, THREE-WAY STOP," OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IN AND FOR THE PARISH OF LIVINGSTON, TO ADD THE INTERSECTION AT GLENBROOKE DRIVE AND MILLSTONE, AND GLENBROOKE DRIVE AND POPLAR GLEN

SECTION 1. Chapter 10 of the Code of Ordinances in and for the Parish of Livingston, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," contains a section, more specifically Section 10-9(a), designating specific intersections as three-way stops and ordering the installation of stop signs.

SECTION 2. La. R.S. 32:42 authorizes local parish authorities to adopt ordinances to regulate, designate, direct and restrict vehicular traffic on highways other than state maintained highways and with respect to public roads within their territorial limits, but outside corporate limits of any municipality therein.

SECTION 3. Be it ordained by the Livingston Parish Council that Section 10-9(a) of the Code of Ordinances of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, is hereby amended to include the following intersections:

Glenbrooke Drive and Millstone Drive
Glenbrooke Drive and Poplar Glen Drive

SECTION 4. The effective date of this ordinance shall be as prescribed by law.

SECTION 5. The above and foregoing addition to the Code of the Parish of Livingston, having been properly introduced and published by title, was thereupon submitted to a vote; the vote thereon was as follows:
