BE IT ORDAINED by the Livingston Parish Council, Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana: The Code of Ordinances of the Parish of Livingston, Louisiana, is hereby amended by adding section, to be numbered Section 11-2.3, "Public Boat Launch Rules", shall read as follows:

Sec. 11-2.3 Public Boat Launch Rules.

Any public boat launch is to be used for the sole purpose of launching boats. No picnicking, loitering, swimming or littering will be allowed.

Fines of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per person will occur for failure to comply.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

The effective date of this ordinance shall be as prescribed by law.
