AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 13, “PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT,” SECTION 13-49.5, “REQUIREMENTS FOR MINOR SUBDIVISIONS WITHOUT IMPROVEMENTS”, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IN AND FOR THE PARISH OF LIVINGSTON.

The following ordinance, which was previously introduced in written form required for adoption at a regular meeting of the Parish Council on July 10, 2014 a summary thereof having been published in the official journal together with a notice of public hearing which was held in accordance with said public notice was brought up for final passage August 14, 2014, on Motion of Marshall Harris and seconded by Joan Landry:

L.P. ORDINANCE 14-17

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 13, “PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT,” SECTION 13-49.5, “REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBDIVISIONS WITHOUT IMPROVEMENTS”, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IN AND FOR THE PARISH OF LIVINGSTON.

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council adopted L.P.O. 01-16, reenacting Chapter 13 of the Code of Ordinances of Livingston Parish, Subdivision Regulations, and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council has adopted numerous amendments to Chapter 13 of the Code of Ordinances and now desires to further amend subsection (B) for a higher visibility of signage thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana: the Code of Ordinances of Livingston Parish, Section 13-49.5. is hereby amended to read as follows:

The following sign will be required for subdivisions without improvements. The O/D/S shall erect a four-foot by eight-foot black and white sign with a minimum of four-inch high letters located on the O/D/S property with no obstructions within five (5) feet of the nearest public right-of-way leading to the subdivision. The bottom of the sign shall be at least four (4) feet from the ground. Twenty-five (25) percent of sign may be dedicated for advertising purposes and graphics, provided such area is contiguous. The sign shall be erected at least ten (10) days prior to the planning commission meeting at which the subdivision is to be considered. The sign must remain visible and upright throughout the construction phase. Failure to keep the sign visible and upright is cause for project work to be stopped by the parish until the sign is corrected. The developer is responsible for any and all associated costs including attorney(s) fees. The sign shall be titled "A Subdivision Is Proposed For This Site" and shall contain the following information:

- (1) Name, address and phone number of O/D/S.
- (2) Name of subdivision or development.
- (3) Number of lots
- (4) Number of acres in the development.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
