L.P. ORDINANCE 14-23

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 13, "PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT," SECTION 13-58, "UTILITIES", OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IN AND FOR THE PARISH OF LIVINGSTON.

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council adopted L.P.O. 01-16, reenacting Chapter 13 of the Code of Ordinances of Livingston Parish, Subdivision Regulations, and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council has adopted numerous amendments to Chapter 13 of the Code of Ordinances and now desires to further amend Section 13-58.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana: the Code of Ordinances of Livingston Parish, Section 13-58(A)(2)(a) is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 13-58 Utilities

(A)(2) (a) Subdivisions having twenty (20) or less lots, each containing sixteen thousand (16,000) square feet or more and with a width of at least eighty (80) feet at building line, may have effluent from an approved individual mechanical system and absorption bed draining to open effluent ditches.

Subdivisions having twenty (20) or less lots, minor or otherwise, with an approved community sewage treatment system, may have lots each containing twelve thousand (12,000) square feet or more and with a width of at least sixty (60) feet at the building line providing the specified lots utilize or tie into the approved community sewerage treatment system. Failure to utilize the approved community sewerage treatment system is cause for project approval to be revoked by the parish and developer is responsible for any and all associated costs including attorney fees.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
