The Chairman, Councilman Shane Mack, called the meeting to order.

The Council Clerk called roll. With everyone being present except Mr. Randy Delatte, **the Chair began by addressing item 3, Old Business:** 

# a. Zoning classification and Modifications of Nonconformities/Nonconforming Uses

Public Input: Eddie Aydell

Mr. Mack explained that the purpose of this ordinance is to allow property owners to keep the use of their property that is currently in use, but they can zone the property for potential future use. He also said that some realtors wanted something in writing that allowed the property use to transfer owners, if the property sold, which Mr. Mack thinks this ordinance does both of those.

Mr. Mack explained that he has made some small changes to the wording in the ordinance to clarify it, to make sure it meets the intent they are trying to achieve. He then read through the ordinance in its entirety, having discussion with the fellow committee members and the public's input.

## b. Modification to Zoning Classification Ordinance

Mr. Eddie Aydell explained that he did not know that the Council was going to adopt the land use/classification ordinance when he sent it the first time. He said there were multiple errors on their part, and it was a rough draft from them. He has now modified the ordinance and thinks that this version is going to clear up some concerns and questions some people may have. He is wanting the Council to take a look at these new classifications and give him some feedback on what they might want changed.
