The chair called the meeting to order and asked the public to please mute or turn off their cell phones.

PUBLIC INPUT

The chair announced that Public Input would be accepted from any member of the audience wishing to address an agenda item.

A PRELIMINARY RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT TO INTRODUCE AND CONSIDER AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF SEWERAGE DISTRICT NO. 2 OF LIVINGSTON PARISH, LOUISIANA; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority set forth in Sub-Part A, Part I, Chapter 9 of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended and the Livingston Parish Home Rule Charter, the Parish Council of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, acting as governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana (the "Council") created Sewerage District No. 2 of Livingston Parish, Louisiana (the "District") by an Ordinance adopted on April 26, 1975, as amended on March 10, 2016 (the "Boundary Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Council may alter the boundaries of the District, upon their own initiative under Sub-Part A, Part I, Chapter 9 of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Parish and the District have identified a need to expand boundaries of the District to better serve the needs of the Parish's residents; and

WHEREAS, adoption of an amendment to the Boundary Ordinance requires that the Council first adopt a preliminary resolution under Section 3884 of Sub-Part A, Part I, Chapter 9 of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, declaring the intention of the Council to alter the boundaries of the District and setting a date for a hearing therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Parish Council of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, as the governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, that:

SECTION 1. The Council hereby declares its intention to alter the boundaries of the District, as required by Section 3884 of Sub-Part A, Part I, Chapter 9 of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, as set forth in an ordinance, to be considered for adoption on June 23, 2016, after conducting a public hearing on Thursday, June 23, 2016 at 6:00 p.m., Central Standard Time, at the Council Chambers in the Governmental Building, 20355 Government Blvd., Livingston, Louisiana.

SECTION 2. The Chairman and Council Clerk of the Council, along with the Parish President, are further authorized and directed to do any and all things necessary and incidental to carry out the provisions of this Resolution.
