**PARISH COUNCIL OF THE PARISH OF LIVINGSTON, STATE OF LOUISIANA**

The following resolution was offered by John Wascom and seconded by Tracy Girlinghouse:

**LPR NO. 21-235**

A Resolution authorizing Livingston Parish Sewer District to proceed with the issuance and delivery of its not to exceed \$50,000,000 of Sewer Revenue Bonds, in one or more series; and otherwise providing with respect thereto.

WHEREAS, as required by Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, as amended, and La. R.S. 33:1415, it is now the desire of the Parish Council of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, as the governing authority (the "Governing Authority") of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana (the "Parish") to approve the issuance and delivery of not to exceed \$50,000,000 Sewer Revenue Bonds, in one or more series (the "Bonds"), by Livingston Parish Sewer District (the "District"), the proceeds of which will be used by the District for the purposes of (i) acquiring, constructing, extending and improving the sewerage system located within the District (the "Project"); (ii) funding capitalized interest on the Bonds, if necessary; (iii) funding a debt service reserve fund or the purchase of a reserve fund surety, if necessary; and (iv) paying the costs of issuing the Bonds, including the cost of a bond insurance policy, if necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Parish Council, as the governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, that

SECTION 1. In compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, as amended, and La. R.S. 33:1415, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of the District, the Parish Council approves the issuance and delivery of not to exceed \$50,000,000 Sewer Revenue Bonds of the District. The Bonds shall bear interest at a fixed rate or rates not exceeding five percent (5.00%) per annum, shall mature no later than thirty-five (35) years from the date of their issuance, and shall be issued under the authority of Section 1430 of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority, or such other authority as may be determined by resolution at the time of the issuance of the Bonds.

SECTION 2. The Parish President and the Chairman of the Parish Council are hereby authorized and directed to do any and all things necessary and incidental to carry out the provisions of this Resolution and to assist the District in carrying out its functions in connection with the financing.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately.

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The chair addressed addendum item A-1, “Resolution to establish “Link up LIVINGston”, which is a committee to improve broadband and connectivity in Livingston Parish. – Garry Talbert”

The Chair then called upon Representative Buddy Mincey Jr. to introduce this resolution. Representative Mincey spoke about the importance of broadband connectivity for educational and business purposes and the problems that arose during the ongoing pandemic. He continued to talk about money being released to Parishes for broadband connectivity and the need for the committee to begin the process on applying for these funds.

#### **LPR NO. 21-236**

**WHEREAS**, broadband access, or broad bandwidth, provides connections for electronic data on the Internet to become available on a device, whether a cell phone or computer, used by individuals at home or in the office; and

**WHEREAS**, economically, broadband has become a requirement for doing business in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century and the absence of broadband in a community translates to the absence of jobs; and

**WHEREAS**, almost every aspect of running a modern business accomplished online, whether it is in advertising, bookkeeping, restocking inventory, selling directly to customers, and many times, the work itself; and

**WHEREAS**, even with Internet access, many businesses are recognizing a need employees to teleworking from home to foster a better quality of life; and

**WHEREAS**, many residents are leaving our rural areas forcing 20<sup>th</sup> century industries to close or downsize but access to reliable broadband capabilities can provide stability and growth by retaining and attracting workers to these rural areas where they can enjoy that which is unique to our state; and

**WHEREAS**, broadband benefits are wide-reaching and comprehensive and provide additional safety benefits by increasing connectivity in which public safety officials have faster and more dependable communication networks with faster response times; and

**WHEREAS**, telemedicine and healthcare delivery via videoconferencing allows for primary and preventative care being made available to remote and underserved patients; lowering future healthcare costs and leading to better health outcomes; and

**WHEREAS**, educational and technology professionals are working hard to ensure that students have access to high-speed internet in our schools but to guarantee success students

need broadband access at home as well; and

**WHEREAS**, providing universal broadband to all of our students will improve educational performance and provide enhanced career opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Louisiana Office of Broadband Development and Connectivity is charged with assisting local and state entities to develop and maintain the infrastructure so that broadband access is available to all persons in every area of our state, rural and urban with the goal to eliminate the digital divide by 2029.

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Livingston Parish Council wishes to establish a committee called “Link up LIVINGston”, which is a committee to improve broadband and connectivity in Livingston Parish and,
