

**Minutes of the Livingston Parish Council
Livingston, Louisiana
December 16, 2021**

The Livingston Parish Council met in a regular session duly called, advertised, and convened at its regular meeting place, the Parish Council Chambers, Governmental Building, 20355 Government Boulevard, Livingston, Louisiana, on Thursday, December 16, 2021, at the hour of six o'clock (6:00) p.m. with the following Livingston Parish Council members present:

The chair called the meeting to order.

The chair asked the public to please mute or turn off their cell phones.

The chair announced that Public Input would be accepted from any member of the audience wishing to address an agenda item and explained the procedure to be called upon.

The chair addressed agenda item number 7, "Presentations: Christmas Card Art Winner". The chair called upon Councilman Jeff Ard and Councilman Gerald McMorris to present the winner of the Council's Christmas Card contest.

Councilman Jeff Ard explained how the Johnny F. Bell Artistic Achievement Award came to be and presented the award for the Council's annual Christmas card contest to Drake Overton from Frost Elementary School.

Thereupon the chair declared that the Motion had carried and was adopted.

The chair addressed agenda item number 9a, "District Attorney's Report:

The chair advised that this item would be passed over that evening and concurred this with Mr. Christopher Moody, Parish Legal Counsel.

The chair addressed agenda item number 10, "Adopt resolution to request for "NO ATVs or Off Road Vehicles Allowed" signage be placed at the gravel end of Oma Harris Lane, Oma Harris and Hillon Hood and Oma Harris at the Fire station at 4-H Club Road located in Council District 5; State law reference: R.S. 32:299.3 "Off-road vehicles; utility terrain vehicles" called upon Councilman R.C. "Bubba" Harris.

Councilman Harris explained the problems presented at the end of Oma Harris Road where it turns to gravel. Residents have complained that there are individuals who are not only tearing up the road with four-wheelers, but they are also concerned that if the violators are traveling on their private property and one of them gets hurt, there is going to be a lawsuit. Councilman Harris explained that if the signs are erected and there are violations, the Sheriff's office can be contacted.

The Council clerk requested that Councilman Harris state for the record where the signage should be placed.

Councilman Harris advised the following locations for the placement of signage:

- By the Fire Station on Hillon Hood Road where it comes out onto 4-H Club Road
- On the opposite end where Hillon Hood Road comes out onto LA Highway 16
- At the beginning of Oma Harris Road and another where Oma Harris Road turns into gravel

Councilman Randy Delatte wished to ask Mr. Moody how many pending suits there were against the Parish that were either in court, or that were in negotiation. Mr. Moody advised that he would not be able to answer that question for him that evening, but he knew that there were not that many.

The chair addressed agenda item number 20, "Councilmen's comments:" and asked if any of the Council members wished to speak. The chair called upon Councilman Jeff Ard who wanted to wish everyone a merry Christmas and to have a safe holiday. Councilman Shane Mack stated that he wanted to say the same thing and would like to thank Administration for the hard work that was done in the debris cleanup from Hurricane Ida.
