L.P. ORDINANCE 22-37

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND L.P. 22-02, ADOPTED ON MARCH 24, 2022, HEREBY REVISING THE BEGINNING OF THE COUNCIL MEMBERS' TERMS OF OFFICE AND THEIR DISTRICTS WHICH SHALL BE EFFECTIVE FOR ALL PURPOSES FROM THE FIRST MONDAY IN JANUARY FOLLOWING THEIR ELECTION TO THE SECOND MONDAY IN JANUARY FOLLOWING THEIR ELECTION.

WHEREBY, THIS BEING AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE THAT THERE SHALL BE NINE (9) COUNCIL MEMBERS, WHO SHALL EACH REPRESENT ONE (1) OF NINE (9) VOTING DISTRICTS, AND TO ESTABLISH AND PROVIDE FOR THE BOUNDARIES OF THE NINE (9) VOTING DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS, Constable-Justice of the Peace Ward 11, Bobby Smith of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, resigned from his office in written form, effective on December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the six (6) year term of constable that was being served does not expire until December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State, State of Louisiana, office of Kyle Ardoin, informed the Livingston Parish Council clerk in writing that no one had qualified to run for the vacant office of Constable, Justice of the Peace Ward 11, Parish of Livingston, for the fall 2022 special election; and

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists pursuant to La. R.S. 18:585 and must be filled in accordance with the provisions of the constitution or of law; and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council, as governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, shall therefore call a special election for the above specified office within twenty (20) days from the end of qualifying in accordance with La. R.S. 18:402 and La. R.S. 18:602; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with La. R.S. 18:602(E)(2)(a), the Livingston Parish Council hereby calls for an election for the vacancy of office being Constable-Justice of the Peace, Ward 11, and wishes to schedule said election for the fall 2023 Gubernatorial election dates, which are currently scheduled for October 14, 2023 and November 18, 2023, with qualifying dates of August 8, 9, and 10, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Council as governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana failed to find a qualified candidate to fill the vacancy of office for the Constable-Justice of the Peace Ward 11, and hereby requests that the Louisiana Secretary of State transmit notice to the Governor of Louisiana and to do so in accordance with La. R.S. 18:602(D).

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Livingston Parish Council, as governing body of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, hereby calls for an election to be held on the fall 2023 Gubernatorial election dates, which are currently scheduled for October 14, 2023 and November 18, 2023, with qualifying dates of August 8, 9, and 10, 2023.
