The Livingston Parish Council is requesting these agencies hold off on issuing these specific permits until we have had time to obtain necessary information on the hazards and risk associated with these projects and had time to write and establish regulation on a local government level permitting these activities to be performed safely. The activities within Livingston Parish, Livingston Parish Waterways, and Lake Maurepas we would like suspended until these regulations are adopted include but are not limited to detonation of charges for seismic testing, drilling, or injecting liquids into class V and class VI wells where the wells are to be used for testing of rock formation, monitoring, or injection of CO2 into the ground for the sole purpose of storing the CO2 for long term storage.”
