The chair addressed agenda item number 21a, “Committee Report(s): Finance committee” and advised that the committee opted to have the Finance Director present the budget at the Council meeting rather than present it twice at the committee meeting and the Council meeting.

The chair addressed agenda item number 21b, “Committee Report(s): Ordinance committee: Recommendation(s) for Introduction of Ordinance(s):”.

Councilman Tracy Girlinghouse, Ordinance committee chairman, advised that Councilman Shane Mack facilitated their committee meeting earlier that evening.

Councilman Shane Mack suggested that the Council go over the ordinances that they were proposing at that evening’s Council meeting. Councilman Garry Talbert advised that the committee had a positive recommendation for the ordinance proposed by Mr. Moody and that was supported by the Planning Department. Councilman Mack discussed the specifics of the proposed ordinance amending Section 100-5.

After the discussion of the proposed ordinance, the Council failed to have the ordinance read by title, assign an ordinance number and set the date for the public hearing. This ordinance will be re-introduced at the next available meeting of the Livingston Parish Council.

He advised that this was a recommendation of Morgan Sanchez, Parish Review Engineer. The amendments could not be introduced that evening because they were not presented in ordinance form to be presented when it would be adopted. This ordinance will be proposed to be introduced at the next available meeting of the Livingston Parish Council.

The chair addressed agenda item number 22, "District Attorney's Report:". Mr./ Moody advised that he did not have anything to report at that time.

Councilman Randy Delatte requested to speak and advised in the interest of the vote for an interim Council member, he would like to change his vote to make it unanimous so a sitting councilman will be unanimous.

No one objected to this request to change his vote from "Nay" to "Yea".

There was an open discussion to continue the Trunk-or-Treat event in the future in honor of Mr. Harris.

Having no further business, a motion to adjourn was requested until the next regular meeting being scheduled on Thursday, December 8, 2022, at the hour of six o'clock (6:00) p.m. in Livingston, Louisiana.
