The Livingston Parish Council met in a regular session duly called, advertised, and convened at its regular meeting place, at the Governmental Building in the Parish Council Chambers, 20355 Government Boulevard, Livingston, Louisiana, on Wednesday, December 21, 2022, at the hour of six o'clock (6:00) p.m. with the following Livingston Parish Council members present:

The chair called the meeting to order.

The chair asked the public to please mute or turn off their cell phones.

Mr. Harrell explained that he was requesting a resolution to be adopted to authorize the Parish President to sign a contract with Forte and Tablada for a sewer mitigation project in Walker that would be exchanging out many of the manhole covers.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND PART III, “LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE”, CHAPTER 100, “GENERAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS”, SECTION 100-5, “PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS CHAPTER”, BY ADDING AN AMENDMENT FOR THE ALLOWANCE OF ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO WRITE CITATIONS AND SUMMONS FOR COURT APPEARANCES.

Having no other discussion, the chair moved to the next agenda item.

The chair addressed agenda item number 14, “Grant waiver to Mack Industries to operate gravel mine with the contingency that the waiver is for H&H Study for one (1) year located in Council District 2”, and called upon Councilman Garry Talbert who asked if this could be deferred until January 12th.

The chair addressed agenda item number 15, “Adopt a resolution to grant a waiver of .26 acres that is zoned R2 on Reinninger Road in Council District 1” and acknowledged that he wished to explain the circumstances of this request.

Councilman Jeff Ard explained that the property in question was zoned rural in that area. The Parish’s zoning ordinance mandates that rural zoning must be presented as one (1) acre lots. The current map of the property consists of five (5) lots that are measured at .33 acres. The party in question is requesting that that they be allowed to combine the three (3) back lots on the property into one (1) lot, which will be just over an acre. The front lot will be one (1) of two (2) lots combined which will be .08 acres. It is not quite an acre, but the intent and zoning in rural, is to make bigger lots. It was his opinion that two (2) smaller lots would be combined to make a bigger lot, then he was in favor of the waiver request.
