- A-1: Discussion and Enquiry of Administration’s Notice of Contract Termination of Steve Irving, who was engaged on May 25, 2023 (LPR NO. 23-229) by the Livingston Parish Council to provide Legal Services as the Parish’s Planning and Zoning attorney, to advise regarding the adoption and implementation of Zoning and Land Use Planning – Randy Delatte
- A-2: Discussion of Veto Statement of L.P. No. 23-26, “Twelve (12) month moratorium: Prohibition of preliminary site plans for subdivisions with and without improvements into more than fifty (50) lots or more than one hundred (100) acres and multi-family developments” – Chairman/Clerk of the Council/Parish Legal Counsel/Randy Delatte
- A-3: Introduction of ordinance:
An ordinance to adopt a Parish-wide moratorium prohibiting the submittal of any applications for a preliminary plat for a subdivision with improvements for period of one hundred twenty (120) days or until the adoption of an updated zoning ordinance (whichever occurs first) – Jeff Ard
- A-4: Adopt a resolution granting two (2) waivers for Section 125-37 (4), “Requirements for Minor Subdivisions”, and Section 125-126 (b) & (c), “Wetland Regulations; Prohibited and Permitted Uses”, for Malcolm Ray and Holly Forbes located off of Bebe Lane in Council District 8 (*deferred from the June 8, 2023 regular meeting of the Livingston Parish Council as requested by the property owners*) – Randy Delatte
